Miles City Council met in regular session on February 3, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at Miles City Hall. Council members present were: Tim Volquardsen, Dale Cassaday, Jennifer Machande, and Jesse Speer. Mayor Mike Portz presided.

Motion by Machande and seconded by Speer to dispense with reading of the minutes. Motion carried, 4 ayes, 0 nays.

Motion by Speer and seconded by Volquardsen to approve the agenda with 1 addition. Motion carried, 4 ayes, 0 nays.

The police report was presented. There were 82 contact hours made during January. The contract with the Preston Police Department was distributed, and will be reviewed at the February meeting. The police tagged cars that were not moved for snow removal. Motion made by Volquardsen, seconded by Speer to approve police report. Motion carried, 4 ayes, 0 nays.

Motion by Machande and seconded by Cassaday to approve the Finance Report. Motion carried, 4 ayes, 0 nays.

Motion by Speer and seconded by Volquardsen to approve all bills. Motion carried, 4 ayes, 0 nays.

Mayor's report: 1) State Court Administrator. 2) Jackson County Area Tourism Minutes, Agenda and Director's Report. 3) December sewer report. 4) ICAP credit.

Building and maintenance concerns. 1) Snow removal concerns. 2) Black dirt will be needed for the park and cemetery.

Clerks' Report: 1) There has been an inquiry on Hansen's 4th Addition lots.

Motion by Volquardsen and seconded by Speer to pass 3rd reading of Ordinance 15-3– Utility rates. Motion carried by roll: Cassaday aye, Machande aye, Volquardsen aye, Speer aye.

Motion by Machande and seconded by Cassaday to pass Resolution 721-1 – Re-appointing City Officials, Standing Committees, and Designations for 2 year term. Motion carried by roll: Cassaday aye, Machande aye, Volquardsen aye, Speer aye.

A motion by Machande and seconded by Cassaday to publish the Budget for 2016-2017, and have a public hearing on March 2, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. Motion carried, 4 ayes, 0 nays.

The TOMRV bicycle tour will be riding through Miles on June 11, 2016.

An offer has been received on lots 15-B and 16 in Frahm's First Addition. The lawyer will be contacted to start the necessary paperwork.

Motion by Speer, and seconded by Volquardsen to increase Dan's salary. Motion carried, 3 ayes, 0 nays, 1 abstain.

A discussion was held on the garbage contract. More research will be done on options for collection.

Motion by Cassaday and seconded by Machande to adjourn at 7:40 p.m.. Motion carried, 4 ayes, 0 nays. Next meeting March 2, 2016.
