PLEASE VOTE ON SPECIAL ELECTION NOVEMBER 8: The Miles City Council has asked for a motion to be put on the November election. Currently, all LOSST (1% sales tax) funds are put in the Economic Development fund. We are proposing to divide the money 50% between the General fund and the Economic Development fund. The motion will be on the back of the general election ballot. Please turn the ballot over to vote for approval of this new distribution of current funds.

HALLOWEEN – “Trick or Treat” hours will be Sunday October 30 from 4-6 p.m. If possible, turn on your porch lights. Motorists should be careful of children crossing the street. Miles area businesses will again be hosting a Halloween Festival accompanying “Trick or Treating”. The event will take place from 5-7 p.m. at the Miles Legion. Food, games, raffles, etc. will take place. Please join us for the fun!

WATER MAINS – Water mains will be flushed on October 12 and 13. We recommend that you do not wash clothes during this time, due to the possibility of rust in the water.

BURNING – Only leaves and small limbs can be burned. Be considerate of others when burning. The compost piles at Threshers Ground are for limbs and grass clippings. Yard waste in bags will be picked up by 8 a.m. on Mondays and Thursdays.

WINTER – SNOW REMOVAL - Please remove vehicles from the streets when you know there will need to be snow removal. It makes it so much easier and a better job of removal can be done! Reminder, accumulation of snow and ice must be removed from the sidewalks within 24 hours after snowfall. Violation of this will result in the City removing the snow at a rate of \$50 per hour and charged to the property owner.
